Dear Members,

As of the AATA meetings this coming April, I will have completed one year as the Treasurer for our association. In this time, I have tried to focus on learning the responsibilities of the Treasurer position and the procedures involved with the day to day operations of the AATA.

Over the past year our finances have stayed stable despite world markets still being in an unpredictable position. As of December 31, 2009 we had approximately \$18,000 in our daily operating accounts with approximately another \$15,000 in GIC's and \$50,000 in an investment fund. In meeting with our financial planners we have maintained a conservative approach in our goals for investments, focusing on long term growth rather than short term gains.

Prior to the AATA's general meeting, I will have completed our 2010 budgetary report. Within our 2010 budget there will be spending increases on educational and promotional programs for both the membership and the general public. We have approved increased budget amounts to the Marketing Committee so that they may continue to promote the benefits of Athletic Therapy to the provincial government, insurance providers and other health care professionals. This budget increase will also allow the Marketing Committee to attend more public events to promote Athletic Therapy as a healthcare option to the general public.

I look forward to the next year as Treasurer of the AATA and continuing to serve our members to the best of my abilities.
