

## Ethics Committee Application

The AATA Ethics Committee is a body of professional Athletic Therapists who will investigate and adjudicate alleged AATA Code of Ethics Violations. The Ethics Committee is a valued part of the AATA as it elevates the Association's professional status. It shows that our profession is serious about maintaining a high level of public safety. Concern for a client's well being is the corner stone of excellence in all health delivery models.

The Ethics Committee is made up of twelve (12) members. Nine (9) members function on the true working ethics board. They will investigate, and adjudicate violations that are brought to the Association's attention. The remaining three (3) members will form the Complaints Review Committee. This committee will function primarily in the role of alternative complaint resolution and ratification.

Members of the Ethics Committee must be in good standing with the AATA/CATA and can not sit on any other Provincial or National Committee or executive with the exception of the CATA Ethics Committee.
